I am currently an Associate Professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, University of Nairobi and a Specialist Obstetrician Gynaecologist, Kenyatta National Hospital Nairobi, Kenya. I hold a Master's Degree in Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Postgraduate Diploma in Biomedical Research Methodology, Postgraduate Diploma in International Maternal Health Care and Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery Degree. I have an interest in Gynaecologic Oncology.

I have 22 years teaching experience at both Undergraduate and Postgraduate levels in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology and have supervised a total of 25 Postgraduate MMED students to completion. Currently 10 Postgraduate students are at various stages of their thesis development under my supervision.
